The north firehouse will have about \$600 of new gutters installed. Chief and his team researched and presented three specification lists for a new rescue boat. Paul moved and Don seconded to proceed with the purchase of the 23' Sea Hunt at an approximate cost, after a municipality discount, of \$78k. Another \$10k is expected to be spent outfitting the boat with lights, signage, engine protector rails, etc. The motion passed 4-0. The district's smallest boat will be sold.

Overtime pay and potential methods to reduce the amount were discussed.

Ferry Pass has a new chief and a meet & greet with Avalon is scheduled.

Avalon Fire/Rescue will have a public Facebook account. Accepted topics were discussed.

New gloves are needed and will be ordered.
